

Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board

Policy 18

CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDING

- The Board pursuant to provision of the Ohio Revised Code, prefers to fund alcohol, drug addiction and mental health services programs utilizing qualified provider agencies.
- The Board will consider alcohol, drug addiction and mental health services capital projects in Wood County individually on an as-needed basis and only when state matching funds are available and have been appropriated for that specific purpose.
- The Board will evaluate alcohol, drug addiction and mental health services capital projects funding requests based on the Board's strategic plan, broad based community support the approved Board Community Plan and county tax levy funding availability. Refer also to Policy 7 (B) Inspecting Mental Health Residential Facilities-acquiring property.
- The Board requires a minimum vote of 75% of all appointed Board members to fund alcohol, drug addiction and mental health services capital projects.
- **Now, therefore, be it "Resolved",** the above Board activities are affirmed and recommended for inclusion into Board policies.
