CIVIL RIGHTS POLICY

**Purpose**

It is the policy of the Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board to treat all clients without regard to race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex or religion.

**Policy**

The same requirements are applied to all, and clients assigned without regard to race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex or religion. There is no distinction in eligibility for, or in the manner of providing client services. All services are available without distinction to all clients and visitors regardless of race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex or religion. All persons and organizations having occasion either to refer clients for services or to recommend the Board are advised to do so without regard to the potential client's race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex or religion.
