

RESOLUTION #FY2017-19

Approval of a Contract Amendment for Fiscal Year 2017 between the Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board (Board) and Family Service of Northwest Ohio for provision of Reentry Services in the amount not exceeding \$20,000

November 28, 2016

Whereas, the Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS) provided \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2017 to enhance services for Wood County residents reentering the community from jail or prison who suffer from mental illness and/or substance abuse, and

Whereas, the use of these funds is to be determined by the Wood County Reentry Coalition and flow through the Board, and

Whereas the Wood County Reentry Coalition determined that such residents are in need of guidance and assistance in the reentry process, known as "Boundary Spanner" services and recommended these services be provided by Family Service of Northwest Ohio (Family Services), in conjunction with the jail based assessments and criminal justice liaison services they already provide, and

Whereas, Family Service is willing to provide these services at a cost not exceeding \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2017, and

Whereas, all parties understand that there is no obligation to continue these services beyond FY2017, without subsequent state funding for these efforts, and


The source of funds for these services are exclusively from these funds provided by OMHAS.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Board approves a contract amendment to the FY 2017 Family Service contract in the amount up to, but not more than, \$20,000.
