Whereas, the Board desires to continue evidenced based programing for services within the Wood County system of care, to improve cost- effectiveness for public funds it oversees, and

Whereas, Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) is an evidenced based therapy known to be very effective for these with high suicidal risk, self-harm, addictions, Bipolar Disorder, certain personality disorders and those involved with the criminal justice system; and

Whereas, Treatment Implementation Collaborative, LLC (TIC) is a respected approved trainer in DBT therapy.


Whereas, Continuation Training will cost approximately \$57,500.00, and

Whereas, The source of funding being used for this project is state and local funding sources, specifically, OHMAS allocated addition funding for suicide prevention in the amount of \$10,000 to offset ongoing costs and another \$75,000 in additional Continuum of Care funding provided by the state for use for the project; and

Now Therefore, The Wood County Board approves the contract with TIC for the training during the remainder of FY 19 and first half of FY 20.
