

**AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES SPECIFIC TO THE STATE OPIOID RESPONSE GRANT
BETWEEN A RENEWED MIND AND WOOD COUNTY ALCOHOL, DRUG ADDICTION
AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES BOARD**

Resolution FY2019 – 30

WHEREAS, A Renewed Mind provides mental health and substance use disorder services to the residents of Wood County and incarcerated residents of other counties in the Northwest Region of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, funding for this program comes from OMHAS from the State Opioid Response (SOR) federal funding (CFDA No. 93.788) in the amount of \$220,566 for 2 years; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has agreed to provide services outlined below:


A. Project Direct Link (PDL). The Agency will provide medication assisted treatment for those incarcerated in Wood County from other Northwest Ohio Counties. Clients will receive access to vivitrol injections, if clinically appropriate, prior to release. If a client would prefer, or a different MAT is recommended, they will be referred to a provider upon release, to include all forms of MAT either within Wood County or within adjacent counties.

B. Addiction Response Collaborative. Agency will provide a full-time clinician to serve with the Wood County Addiction Response Collaborative. Clinician will assist in quick response team services to people who experience an overdose in Wood County or are referred by concerned family or friends of someone with an addiction. The Clinician will interact with all local law enforcement jurisdictions, the Wood County Prosecutor’s Office and board-contracted treatment providers.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved the Board approves the Agreement for A Renewed Mind to provide SOR Services.
