Harbor’s Residential Treatment Programs continue to provide services to women in need of residential treatment for substance use disorders. Harbor is working diligently to protect the safety of patients and staff during the COVID-19 pandemic and is pleased to announce that we can personally provide COVID-19 testing to verify a patient is negative for the virus and able to be admitted to our facility.

If you have a woman in need of our residential services, we do require a negative COVID test in the 48 hours prior to admission. This test can be facilitated through your agency, or Harbor will complete testing for COVID-19 prior to admission.

Devlac Hall and The Chrysalis are residential treatment programs offering services that address addiction, negative consequences of use, the process of recovery, and effective ways to cope with mental health issues. Additionally, The Chrysalis offers specialized services for pregnant/post-partum women designed to increase safe and health pregnancies and reduce infant mortality rate through substance use disorder treatment.

Medicaid is preferred, but Harbor will work with local boards for payment whenever possible. Payment arrangements can also be made on an individual basis.
