

**Resolution FY2020-15**

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE WOOD COUNTY ALCOHOL, DRUG ADDICTION AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (WCADAMHS) BOARD AND THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES (WCBDD)**

**November 25, 2019**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 340 of the Ohio Revised Code, the WCADAMHS Board is authorized to contract with service providers to provide comprehensive alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services to the citizens of Wood County in a timely and effective manner;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 5126 of the Ohio Revised Code, the WCBDD ensures the availability of programs, services, and support for those citizens of Wood County with developmental disabilities;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for coordinated services and supports for Wood County individuals who qualify for services from both participating entities pursuant to their respective statutory mandates;

**WHEREAS**, the participating entities have agreed to work collaboratively to provide services for a dually diagnosed client, enrolled in a home and community-based services waiver program administered by WCBDD;

**WHEREAS**, The participating entities have agreed to share the cost of the Client’s waiver match to ensure the Client receives Home and Community Based Waiver Services, cost to the ADAMHS Board will be \$47,465.04, and the source of the funds will be local;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Board approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board and the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities.
