CALL TO ORDER:

Doug Cubberley called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A quorum was present. Doug informed that he is not a part of this committee but does have to appoint a chairman. Jessica Clements is the Chair for this committee moving forward.

OLD BUSINESS:

CSU- Deanna informed that she met with the Regional Directors, and Thom Craig (Pegs Foundation) and an associate were present. They is discussion on creating a Regional Crisis Stabilization Unit modeled after the Adam and Amanda House. More information will be coming forward in future meetings and Deanna will keep Board members informed of discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

ESC Presentation-Kyle Clark informed that they have completed the youth survey for 2020. ESC wanted to give us and the school superintendents a heads up as this will be coming out Friday to the press. Dr. Ivoska presented a summary of the survey in a power point presentation, as the original report is about 125 pages. 10,000 students, grades 5-12, took this survey. Marijuana and nicotine in vaping devices is increasing across the nation, and our numbers are very similar. Heroin use is still dropping, we had a total of 18 kids say they have tried heroin. Illicit drug use is low, but the gateways are making a reappearance. Dr. Ivoska separated the results between nicotine vaping and non-nicotine vaping, and it was found that the numbers for those who do vape nicotine have a higher percentage in the other areas measured.

Outcomes Update-Chris notified the Board that we are working with the agencies, to track outcomes differently, and better. MyOutcomes is more a measure of the therapeutic relationship and not an accurate picture on how well each agency is doing.
