FY23 AOT Attorney Contract – Hackenberg, Feighner, & Werth, LLC

August 22, 2022

WHEREAS, this resolution rescinds approval of Resolution FY2022-44 and associated contract as approved by the Board on June 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board is developing a collaborative Assisted Outpatient Treatment AOT program to assist individuals suffering from mental illness who require treatment and have a history of noncompliance that impairs their ability to be safe within our community; and

WHEREAS, the Board requested proposals from attorneys interested in serving within the Wood County AOT Program; and

WHEREAS, Designated Attorney is a licensed attorney with the required legal knowledge and skill to provide competent legal representation to a person or entity that may petition the Wood County Probate Court to authorize AOT (“Petitioner”); and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to contract with Designated Attorney for the above legal services and Designated Attorney is willing to perform such services;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board approves the AOT Attorney Contract with Hackenberg, Feighner, & Werth, LLC, beginning July 1, 2022, thru June 30, 2023, with a total contract amount not to exceed \$10,000.
