WHEREAS, the Board desires to contract with Designated Attorney for the above legal services and Designated Attorney is willing to perform such services;

THERFORE, be it resolved that the Board approves the AOT Attorney Contract with W. Alex Smith, beginning July 1, 2023, thru June 30, 2024, with a total contract amount not to exceed \$10,000.
