OUR FOUNDING STORY

In 1967, the Ohio 107th General Assembly passed House Bill 648 to establish community mental health and retardation boards. In 1969, the Wood County Board was established.

In 1980, the Ohio legislature enacted House Bill 160 which would split boards into what we now know as Boards of Alcohol, Drug Addiction, and Mental Health and Boards of Developmental Disabilities.



CLEARSPACE



In order to preserve the integrity of our logo, it is important that no other logos, type, or other graphic elements infringe on its space.

The minimum clearspace around the entire logo is equivalent to 1/2 the height of the logo.

Clearspace also defines the minimum distance between the logo and the edge of any design.

Minimum size recommendations preserve the legibility of the logotype at small sizes. At larger sizes, the logo should increase. It must be clearly visible and match the size of communication.

LOGO USAGE

DO

Use the approved WCADAMHS logos on external sites or in marketing communications to promote any contracted agency with services funded by the board.

Use the standard logos in the context of driving awareness to a keyword.

Use the logo as a link to the WCADAMHS website or details on a WCADAMHS partnership.

DO NOT

Use the logo to imply a strategic partnership with the WCADAMHS Board unless approved by the Executive Director.

Modify the logos.

Display the WCADAMHS logo in a manner than is misleading, unfair, defamatory, infringing, libelous, disparaging, obscene, or otherwise objectionable to the WCADAMHS Board.


