

RESOLUTION FY2024-14

CRC ARPA Capital Project

January 22, 2024

WHEREAS, the Wood County Alcohol Drug Addiction Mental Health Services Board (“Board”), designated under Section 340.03 of the Ohio Revised Code as the community addiction and mental health planning agency for Wood County, is obligated and authorized, subject to the rules issued by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS), to evaluate the need for facility services, addiction services, mental health services, and recovery supports in Wood County; and

WHEREAS, CRC desires to develop a full continuum youth crisis center for the Northwest Region, including 10 traditional crisis residential unit beds, 6 intensive care beds for youth who may not be able to manage living in congregate living without putting themselves or others at risk; and

WHEREAS, the crisis center will also offer psychiatric urgent care for youth, continue offering Mobile Response and Stabilization Services (MRSS), and an observation unit; and

WHEREAS, CRC will expand its fleet of vehicles to outfit for transportation of youth safely to and from the unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board applied for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding on behalf of CRC and was awarded approximately \$6.7 million;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the members of the Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board approves this project with an assurance of intent to support CRC’s program consistent with the application and, in addition, to annually monitor the program and operations of the facility to assure compliance.
